WHEREAS, fee fishing is a recreational form of business, serving both tourists and local sports-orientated customers,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the WAIAC requests the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (WDATCP) to clarify its interpretation that ATCP 91.014(1) does not apply to fish sales sold by fee fishing, or to change ATCP 91.014(1) to allow fee fishing sales by the inch
